BACK TO SCHOOL Positive Behavior Supports WORKSHOP



The Michigan Alliance for Families and the Post Adoption Resource Center (PARC) invites you to join us for a special workshop meeting on how to build positive behavior supports for students in the classroom.

Monday August 1st from 6:00 – 8:00pm.

This workshop will introduce Positive Behavior Supports (PBS). Many children have behaviors that are part of their disability. These behaviors may make it difficult to learn, cause harm, or isolate a child from his or her peers. It is important for parents to understand that behavior is communication.

Through this workshop, Michigan Alliance for Families will explain what a Functional Behavior Analysis (FBA) is, and how a FBA leads to the development of a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) that utilizes Positive Behavior Supports (PBS).

Pot luck dinner at arrival, please bring a dish to pass if you are able but there is plenty of food if you cannot. PARC will provide plates, napkins, silverware. Fellowship and training for adults to follow dinner. Childcare and activities provided for kids ages preschool and up with RSVP.
