Who is eligible?

Youth who have been in foster care after their 14th birthday, are currently age 14 to 20 and are eligible for Youth In Transition (YIT) funding. Your local MYOI coordinator can tell you if you are eligible for YIT funding.

How does a youth enroll?

1. Contact the local coordinator. To find out who your local coordinator is, call Jen Baumann, MYOI Analyst, at 517-241-8904.

- 2. Attend orientation.
- 3. Attend eight hours of financial literacy training.
- 4. Complete enrollment packet.
- 5. Take online survey.
- 6. Open an Individual Development Account and personal savings account.
