Belonging Matters—Helping Youth Explore Permanency

Help for talking to youth about the future

A bulletin by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Administration for Children and Families, Children's Bureau is designed to help child welfare and adoption professionals in working with youth living in foster care.

"Based on interviews with young people who were either adopted from foster care or who aged out of the system, the bulletin explores the beliefs, concerns, and emotions that motivate youth to seek or to avoid legal or relational permanency," says AdoptUSKids.

Topics covered by the bulletin include:

• Help youth understand what family, belonging and permanency mean.

- Help youth explore their permanency options what they want and why.
- Don't allow independent living to be glamorized.
- Recognize that family loyalties may affect youths' desire to pursue permanency.
- Encourage birth family connections.
- Everyone's story is unique. Know the youth. Listen. Advocate.
- Be honest and direct with the youth.

Do I need to make a lot of money? Why are so many children available for adoption from foster care older? Are there any younger children available for adoption? Can I adopt just one child in a sibling group?
